KEY POINTS FOR PROPOSERS & SECONDERS TO GO THROUGH WITH APPLICANTS

Entrance and Subscription Fees – see latest figures below.

CASC - Hurst Castle Sailing Club has been registered as a Community Amateur Sports Club (CASC) since 2009. The CASC Scheme is administered by HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC). HCSC's membership of the scheme brings benefits to the club of the order of £5000 per annum from Rate Relief, Gift Aid claimed on donations and an exemption from Corporation Tax. The Clubs fees reflect its CASC status. Annual fees due each 1st January.

Ethos of Club - self-help; all members join in. The Club has no staff.

Volunteering (with training) – Support Boat Crew, Race Officer, Social Events, Club and Grounds Maintenance, General admin.

Dinghy Park – currently a waiting list. When you become a member get your name down quickly if you would like a space. **Club Boats** – the club fleet currently comprises 4 Hartley Dinghies, 4 Zests, 2 Keyhaven Scows, 1 Lymington River Scow, 4 Optimist Dinghies (for junior sailors), 3 x Kayaks. These can be hired by members on a daily basis. The hire fee is £10 per day for adult dinghies, £5 per day for Optimists and £5 per day for Kayaks.

Dinghy Racing – the Club organises weekday and weekend dinghy handicap racing. A programme of events is published at the start if every sailing season.

Dinghy Pottering – the Club facilitates group dingy pottering activities. These take the form of sailing in the Keyhaven River and creeks. Also sailing to more distant locations such as Lymington or Yarmouth. A programme of Pottering days is published at the start of every sailing season.

Access to Club – access to the club is by key code. When members join, they are given the access codes for the Clubhouse and Gear Store. Members need to make sure that the clubhouse is locked when leaving.

Mobile Phones - no mobile phone use in the Clubhouse or on the veranda.

Smoking – no smoking in the Clubhouse or on the veranda. This includes E cigarettes.

Dogs- welcome in the grounds but not allowed in the Clubhouse or on the veranda.

Launching Boats – boats are launched from the beach. Please do not block the beach before or after launching particularly during the busy summer sailing season.

Boat wash-down area – there is a wash down area at the front of the Clubhouse grounds. Please wash down your boat quickly after sailing so that others can also access this facility. Turn off the tap after use; the Club's water is metered. **Coffee Mornings** – every Tuesday at 10:00.

Social Activities – social events are run throughout the year. A full programme is published at the start of every season. **Club Clothing –** the Club offers a range of clothing. See website for details www.hcsc.org.uk
